Changes in the territory of Slovenia

According to the Surveying and Mapping Administration of the Republic of Slovenia, Slovenia's territory decreased by 2 km², from 20,273 km² to 20,271 km² (Register of Spatial Units, 13 April 2018).

In line with the final award by the arbitration tribunal based on the arbitration agreement between the Government of the Republic of Slovenia and the Government of the Republic of Croatia (*OJ RS – International treaties, No. 11/10*), promulgated on 29 June 2017, the recording of the state border between the Republic of Slovenia and the Republic of Croatia is stipulated by the **Recording of the State Border with the Republic of Croatia Act** (hereinafter the Act), adopted on 27 November 2017 and in force since 9 December 2017.

Changes in the territory of Slovenia and the length of the state border were enforced on 29 December 2017, when – based on the Act and the cartographic presentation of the state border between the Republic of Slovenia and the Republic of Croatia – in the state border record the Surveying and Mapping Authority of the Republic of Slovenia (GURS) implemented in line with the arbitration tribunal's award the procedure of recording the data on the state border points with the Republic of Croatia.

In the Register of Spatial Units – which is for SURS the main source of data on the territory of Slovenia and the territories of other spatial units – on the basis of the **Decree on the Borders of Settlements Along the State Border With the Republic of Croatia in Line With the Arbitration Tribunal's Award** (*OJ RS, No. 7/18*), published on 7 February 2018, in force since 8 February 2018, changes were implemented by GURS on 13 April 2018. In view of the updating of the register data on spatial units, SURS has been applying all implemented changes in the territory of Slovenia and the territories of other spatial units for statistical purposes since 1 July 2018.
