



Changes in areas of cohesion regions

Data on cohesion regions in Slovenia are generally changed every three years according to the procedure stipulated in the NUTS Regulation.

Based on the amended NUTS regulation, NUTS 2 regions (cohesion regions) changed due to the transition of municipality Litija from NUTS 2 region (cohesion region) Zahodna Slovenija to NUTS 2 region (cohesion region) Vzhodna Slovenija. NUTS 2 region (cohesion region) Zahodna Slovenija is now 221 km ² smaller and NUTS 2 region (cohesion region) Vzhodna Slovenija 221 km ² larger.
