



Total output of environmental protection services in 2017 1.1% higher than in 2016

Environmental protection expenditure accounts, Slovenia, 2017

In 2017 the total output of environmental protection services was higher by 1.1% and the total environmental protection expenditure by 10.7% than in 2016.

The total output of environmental protection services in 2017 higher than in 2016

In 2017 the total output (market and non-market output) of environmental protection services amounted to EUR 472.2 million, which is 1.1% more than in 2016.

Output of environmental protection services of specialised producers amounted to EUR 198.3 million, which is 4.2% more than in 2016. Output of these services by ancillary producers decreased by 2.5% to EUR 191.8 million, while output of these services by the general government increased by 2.5% to EUR 82.1 million.

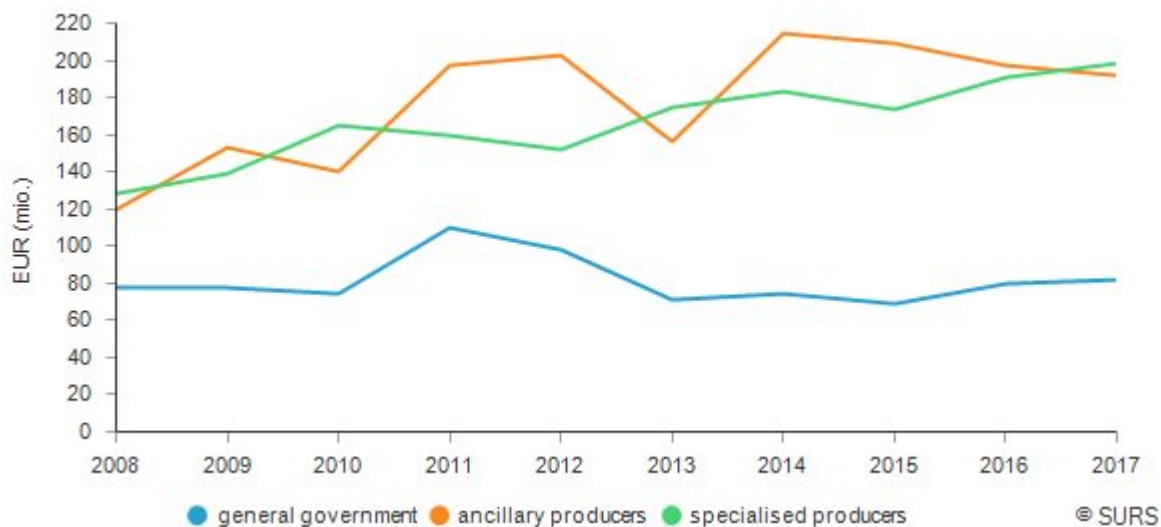
Total environmental protection expenditure in 2017 10.7% higher than in 2016

The total environmental protection expenditure (expenditure of general government, specialised and ancillary producers) in 2017 amounted to EUR 482.1 million, which is 10.7% more than in 2016.

Specialised producers spent EUR 78 million on environmental protection or 15.3% less than in 2016. On the other hand, ancillary producers spent EUR 252.8 million or 66.1% more than in the previous year. Environmental protection expenditure of the general government amounted to EUR 151.3 million, which is 20.9% less than in 2016.

In 2017 the total environmental protection expenditure represented 1.1% of gross domestic product (GDP), i.e. the same as in 2016.
