



In March 2021, producer prices up by 0.2% at the monthly level and by 2.0% at the annual level

Producer price indices, Slovenia, March 2021

In March 2021, producer prices increased by 0.2% compared to February 2021 and were 2.0% higher than in March 2020.

In March 2021, producer prices 0.2% higher at the monthly level

In March 2021, producer prices increased on average by 0.2% compared to February 2021. The prices of manufactured goods sold on the domestic market went up by 0.1%, and the prices of exported products by 0.3%.

The prices of industrial products sold on the markets of the euro area countries increased by 0.5%, while the prices of industrial products sold on the markets of the non-euro area countries decreased by 0.2%.

Among groups of activities showing the dynamics of prices by end-use of products, intermediate goods prices increased by 0.4%, capital goods prices by 0.1% and energy prices by 0.1%. Consumer goods prices decreased by 0.2%.

Compared to the previous month, producer prices increased the most in water collection, treatment and supply (by 1.8%), followed by manufacture of basic metals and manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (both by 1.4%). On the other hand, prices decreased the most in manufacture of wearing apparel (by 1.0%) and in manufacture of paper and paper products (also by 1.0%).

In March 2021, producer prices 2.0% higher than a year ago

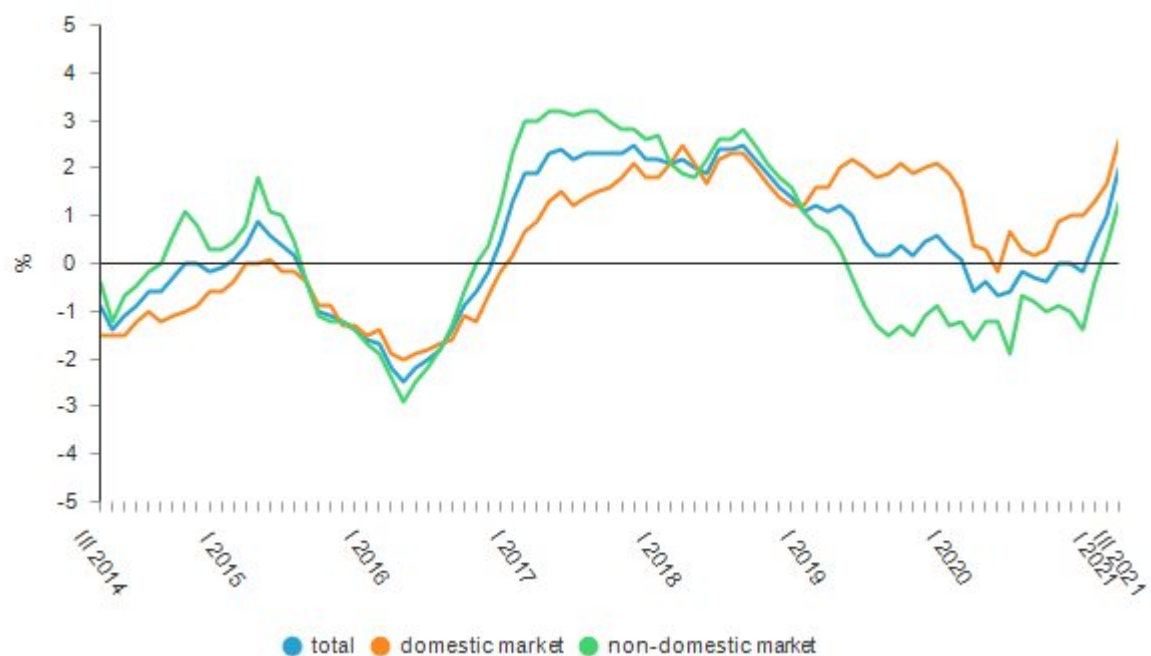
From March 2020 to March 2021, producer prices on average went up by 2.0%. In the same period the prices on the domestic market increased by 2.6% and on the non-domestic market by 1.3%.

The prices of industrial products sold on the markets of the euro area countries increased by 2.2%, while the prices of industrial products sold on the markets of the non-euro area countries decreased by 0.6%.

In one year prices went up the most in manufacture of leather and leather products (by 9.7%). On the other hand, a noticeable price decrease was recorded in manufacture of coke and petroleum products (by 3.3%).
