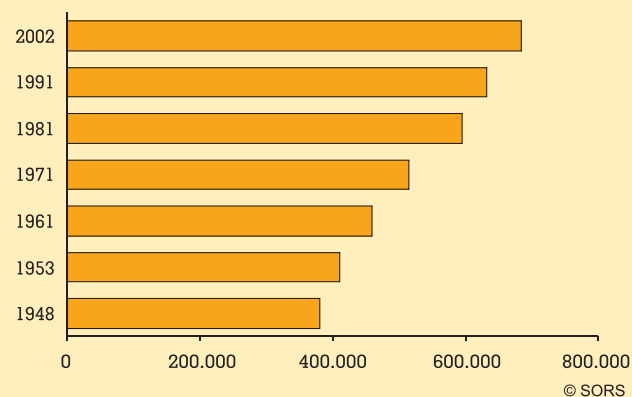

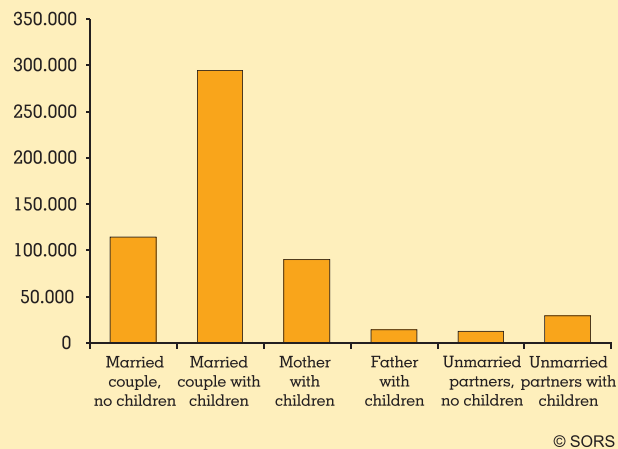

First register-based census in Slovenia

The register-based census 2011 is going to be the first census of population, households and dwellings in the Republic of Slovenia carried out without fieldwork.

Data linkage

More than 20 administrative and statistical data sources will be linked together to produce census data.

Legal basis

- Regulation (EC) No 763/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 on population and housing censuses
- Annual Programme of Statistical Surveys

Register-based censuses in the EU

By carrying out a register-based census Slovenia joins few European countries (Denmark, Finland, the Netherlands) which already produced register-based census data.

Advantages of a register-based census

- No fieldwork
- No respondent burden
- Significant budget savings
- No additional employment
- Quality output data
- Less time for processing
- More frequent data (not only once per 10 years)
