1 PURPOSE

The purpose of the monthly, quarterly and annual publication of data in the field of transport is to display results and indicators related to transport, which are the basis for monitoring trends, volume and structure of transport and traffic in the various modes of transport.

The main statistics are:

- Number of passengers in different transport or traffic modes
- Number of passenger-kilometres in different transport or traffic modes
- Transport of goods and traffic in tonnes and tonne-kilometres in different transport or traffic modes
- Number of passenger cars per 1,000 population
- Average age of passenger cars
- Number of arrivals of passengers and vehicles across road border crossings with Croatia

2 EXPLANATIONS

Derived indicators in the field of transport:

Share of rail goods transport in total inland goods transport according to the tkm (%). The basis for this indicator are tonne-kilometres performed in road and rail freight transport. Road transport includes all tonne-kilometres performed as national transport in Slovenia and international transport with goods loaded or unloaded in Slovenia by road vehicles registered in Slovenia. Not included are international cross-trade and cabotage. Rail transport includes all tonne-kilometres performed by rail vehicles on the territory of Slovenia, regardless of the nationality of the vehicle.

Share of car transport in total inland passenger transport according to the pkm (%). Total passenger transport includes transport by passenger cars, buses and coaches, and trains on the territory of Slovenia. All transport is based on movements on the national territory, regardless of the nationality of the vehicle. The basis for this indicator is passenger kilometres.

Number of passenger cars per 1,000 population. The number of passenger cars registered in Slovenia on 31 December and the population in Slovenia on 1 January of the following year are taken into account. Special purpose passenger cars are excluded.

Average age of passenger cars. Passenger cars registered in Slovenia on 31 December are included. Special purpose passenger cars are excluded.

3 PUBLISHING

Data are published:

Monthly:

- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Road transport – Road passenger transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.
- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Maritime transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.
- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Air transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.
- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Registered road vehicles. Absolute data and seasonally adjusted data are published.

- First Release (Transport): »Transport, Slovenia, monthly«.

Quarterly:

- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Road transport – Road goods transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.
- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Railway transport – Rail passenger transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.
- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Railway transport – Rail goods transport. Absolute data are published at the level of Slovenia.

Annually:

- SiStat Database: Economy – Transport – Transport by modes. Absolute, relative data, various indicators are published by cohesive regions (NUTS 2), by statistical regions (NUTS 3) and by municipalities (SKTE 5).
